2024 Rules and Conditions of Entry

Entries open on **Thursday 1 August 2024** and close at 5pm on **Friday 20 September 2024**. Details of artwork can be changed until closing date. A digital image of the work should be included with the entry form. Entry numbers are limited. Entries will be accepted in the order they are received. The last entry accepted will be at the discretion of the KAA committee.

Entries are invited to the following categories:

- 2D Painting
- 2D Other media (includes drawing, collage, fabric art, printing, photography etc)
- 2D work must:
 - be ready to hang (with D-rings), be no greater than 1000mm x 1000mm including any frame
- 3D Sculpture and all 3D media
- 3D work must:
 - be no greater than 1000mm x 1000mm x 1000mm
 - be no more than 20 kg, be able to be moved easily
 - be transportable with suitable protective packaging
 - not environmentally degrade during the exhibition
- Emerging Artist
 - Chosen from any of the above 3 categories when meeting the Emerging Artist criteria. If you wish to be considered for the Emerging Artist Award explain in less than 500 words why you should be considered an emerging artist. Attach separately to the entry form if necessary.
- Youth
 - Chosen from any of the above 3 categories when meeting the Young Artist criteria. If you are 16 years or younger at time of entry. Please request to be entered in this category.

Eligibility

- Work must not infringe NZ copyright laws
- Work must not have been exhibited in a public exhibition prior to these Kaipara Art Awards
- The work must have been created since the last KAA in October 2022
- One entry per artist. Fee of \$30 (non-refundable after entry form acceptance)
- Work must be suitable to exhibit to a G (family) audience
- Current financial membership of any art group in the Kaipara Region is required. It is not a requirement to be resident in Kaipara.
- The KAA committee has sole discretion to accept or decline an entry
- Works which utilise the operations of AI (artificial intelligence) programmes, applications or processes are ineligible for inclusion in the Kaipara Art Awards, and the utilisation of such technologies will disqualify a work from judging and display

Presentation

- Work must be clearly identified with artist name, address, title of work, medium used, selling price and category **on a label** on the back right hand corner of work **or on a swing tag**
- All entries **MUST** be 'ready to hang' or display. Work not 'ready to hang' or display will not be accepted. For paintings use D-rings do not screw hooks or saw tooth hangers.
- Work being delivered to Dargaville for shipment to Mangawhai must be well packaged in reusable material suitable for vehicle transport **with the packaging clearly labelled with the artist's name** (so we can match it with the work after it has been unwrapped). It is essential packaging can withstand being wrapped and unwrapped several times. Poorly packaged work will not be accepted at sign in.

Sales and Commission:

Works are preferred to be for sale. Commission of 20% will be charged on sales. The sale price stated on the entry form should be inclusive of 20% commission. Artists will be contacted if their artwork is sold. Include bank account number on entry form. Net proceeds will be transferred at the end of the final exhibition.

The KAA committee has sole discretion to allow the removal of a work during the exhibition by an artist. If the removed work is sold privately, commission that would have been payable may or may not be waived by the KAA committee.

Unsold work must be collected from the gallery it was originally delivered to (unless arranged otherwise) on the day and time specified in the attached timeline. After this date the KAA committee has the right to sell or dispose of any unclaimed work.

Judging

The judging panel is independent of the KAA committee. Incorrect entry procedure or failure to observe the conditions may disqualify an entry, at the discretion of the KAA committee. Winners will be determined by the judge(s). The awards will be presented at an Awards ceremony on **Friday 18 October 2024 at 6pm Bennetts Cafe Atrium, Mangawhai.**

Insurance

Artists are responsible for insurance of their work. All care will be taken of works accepted for entry but no responsibility rests with the KAA committee.

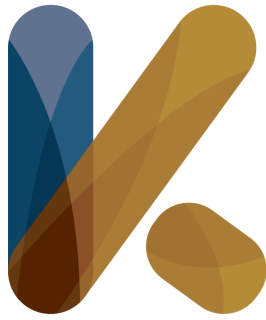

Thursday	1 August	Entries open (with expression of interest)
Friday	20 September	Closing date for entries to be received by KAA committee by 5pm. Confirmed details of entry, size, name, price etc including a digital image of the work (including works in progress) must be received by this date.
Wednesday	16 October	Works to be delivered to either Mangawhai Artists Gallery or Lifestyler House, 107 River Rd Dargaville. Work delivered to Dargaville must be well packaged with packaging well labelled. Gallery staff at each location will accept and sign works in on the day. NB: The location where you drop off your artwork is the location you will collect your artwork from at the end of the final exhibition – unless you have arranged otherwise. Drop off at Dargaville between 9am and 12 noon. Drop off at Mangawhai between 4pm and 5pm
Wednesday	16 October	At 1pm works received at Lifestyler House will be transported to Mangawhai Artists Gallery 3.30 pm Dargaville works arrive at Mangawhai As work arrives in Mangawhai, MAI staff will unwrap and fold packaging and prepare work for curation. 5pm Curator will arrange work.
Thursday	17 October	MAI staff will display and hang eligible art works, on advice of the curator. Judging evening preview.
Friday	18 October	Judging (morning/afternoon) Certificates prepared Gala opening night 5.30pm for 6pm start. Bennetts Cafe Atrium
Saturday	19 October	Exhibition open to the public at 10.30am
Wednesday	30 October	Exhibition closes at 3.30pm. Works packaged and ready for transport to Dargaville
Thursday	31 October	10am Artwork for Dargaville collection transported to Dargaville. 10am - 12:00 Artwork for Mangawhai collection available to pickup, prompt pickup essential, to clear the space for the incoming exhibition
Friday	1 November	Dargaville Artworks ready for pickup from Lifestyler House from 8am- 4pm.
