Basis of Preparation*
Mangawhai Artists Incorporated has elected to apply PBE SFR-A (NFP) Public Benefit Entity Simple Format Reporting - Accrual (Not-
For-Profit) on the basis that it does not have public accountability and has total annual expenses of equal to or less than \$2,000,000.
All transactions in the Performance Report are reported using the accrual basis of accounting. The Performance Report is prepared
under the assumption that the entity will continue to operate in the foreseeable future.
Goods and Services Tax (GST)*
Goods and Services Tax (GST)*
Mangawhai Artists Incorporated is not registered for GST. Therefore amounts recorded in the Performance Report are inclusive of GST (if any).
Income Tax
Mangawhai Artists Incorporated is wholly exempt from New Zealand income tax having fully complied with all statutory conditions
for these exemptions.
Bank Accounts and Cash
Bank accounts and cash in the Statement of Cash Flows comprise cash balances and bank balances (including short term deposits)
with original maturities of 90 days or less.
Property, plant and equipment
Property, plant and equipment is measured initially at cost. Cost includes expenditure that is directly attributable to the acquisition of
the items. Property, plant and equipment is measured subsequently at cost, net of acumulated depreciation and impairment losses, it any.
Depreciation
Depreciation is charged on a 20% diminishing value basis on Furniture and Fittings over the estimated useful life of the asset.
Depreciation on the building extension (Building Improvements) is charged on a straightline basis over the remaining term of the lease which expires on 31 July 2029.
Donations, fundraising revenue
This revenue is recognised upon receipt and includes donations from the general public, donations received for a specific project and donations received from fundraising events.
Changes in Accounting Policies*
There have been no changes in accounting policies during the financial year and they have been applied on a consistent basis with those used in previous years, except for the rewording of the Depreciation policy to improve clarity.
